


• Induction cum Parent Meet (Newly Admitted Students)





















• Teachers Day Celebration (04/09/2021):









Daily Schedule:

Staying arrangement:

Three rooms of Bhaktanivas of Shrinath Mhaskoba Trust were taken and utilized for staying of NSS volunteers and keeping of NSS departmental materials.

Project Completed:
