The college was established in the year 1993 with Degree Course in pharmacy (B. Pharm. Intake-60); and M. Pharm. course in Pharmaceutical Chemistry (Intake -18) was introduced in 2004-05, and M. Pharm. course in Pharmaceutics (Intake-10), M. Pharm. course in Pharmacology (Intake-10) in 2007-08. The college has been approved as Research center for Ph. D. in Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences by Savitribai Phule Pune University since academic year 2008-09. The college has introduced a Pharm course in 2019-20 (60 intake).

The college has the approval of various governing bodies like All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) New Delhi, Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) New Delhi, Government of Maharashtra and is permanently affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University. The college has been recognized under 2(f) & 12 (B) by UGC since 2012. The college has been accredited by NAAC with 'A' grade in cycle-2 on 28/02/2022. It received 'Best College Award' from Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune on 10th Feb 2016.

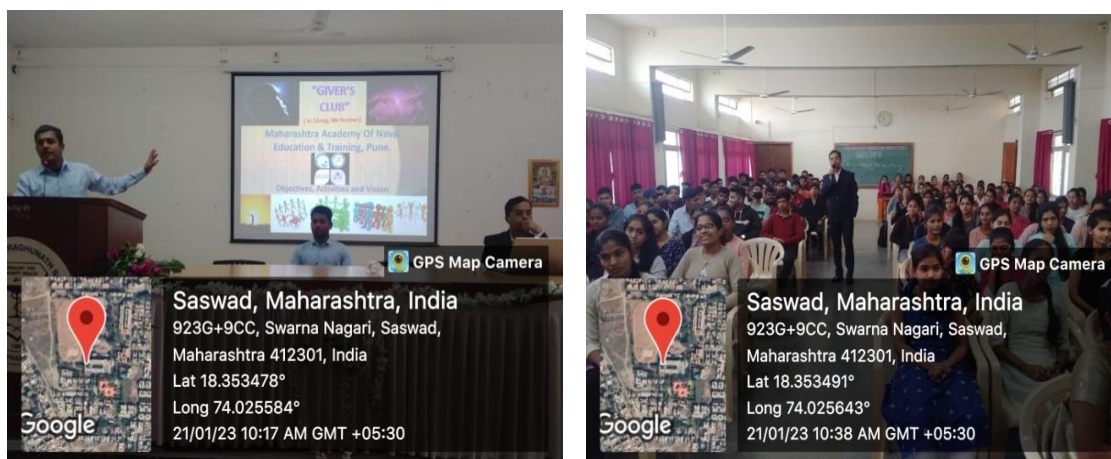
Name of activity: Guest lecture on Spirituality and Personality Development by Dr. Sachin Nirgude, Chaitanya Hospital, Saswad

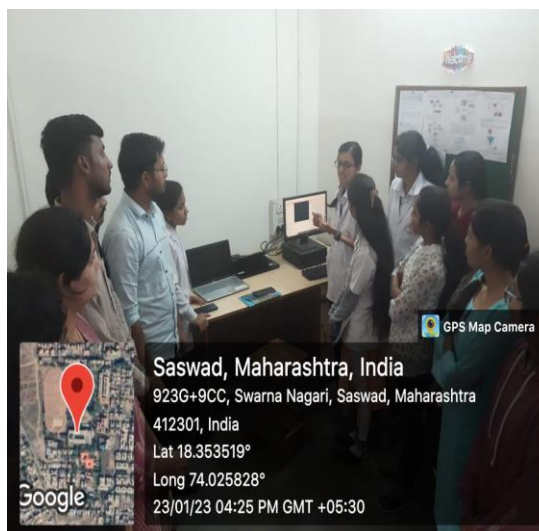

Name of Activity: Guest Lecture on Peer Pressure Management by Dr. Sunil Shinde, HOD, Psychology Department, Waghire College, Saswad

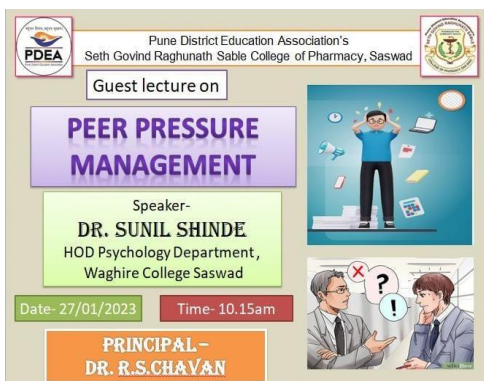

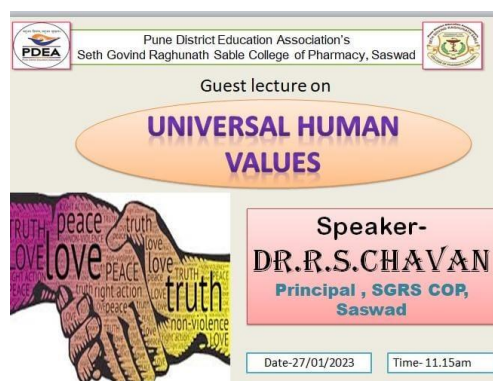
Name of Activity: Guest Lecture on Universal Human Values by Dr. Rajashree Chavan Principal, SGRS COP, Saswad

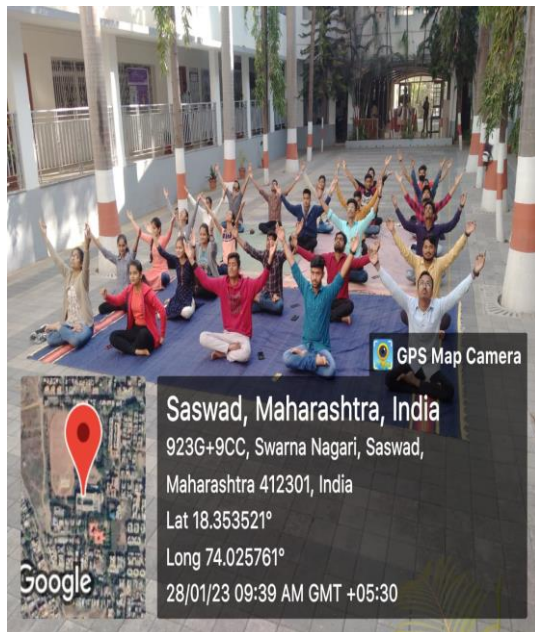

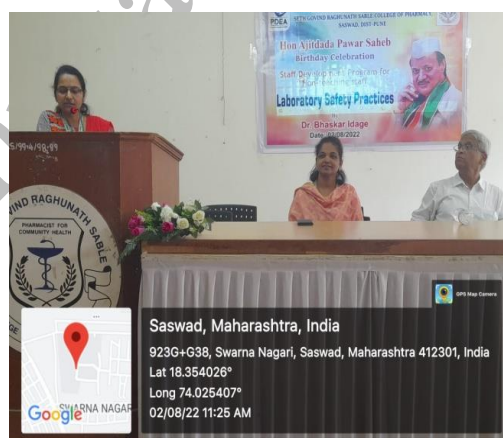


❖ Laboratory Safety Practices for Non Teaching Staff

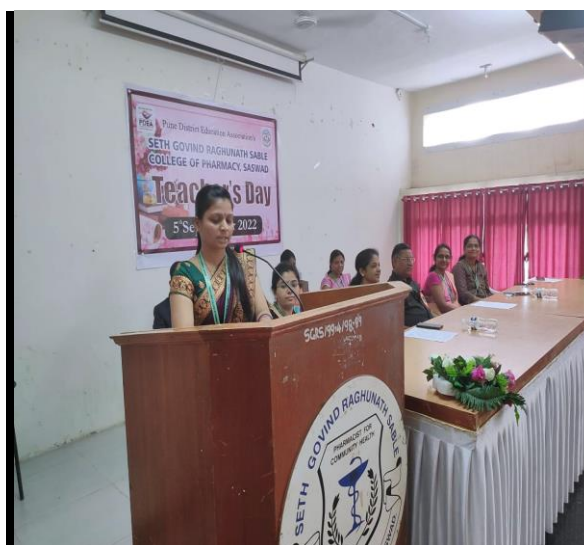


❖ Teacher's Day Celebration (05/09/2022)

In addition to 'Shramdan' projects, various other activities have been carried out during camp period in the village. These are as follows:

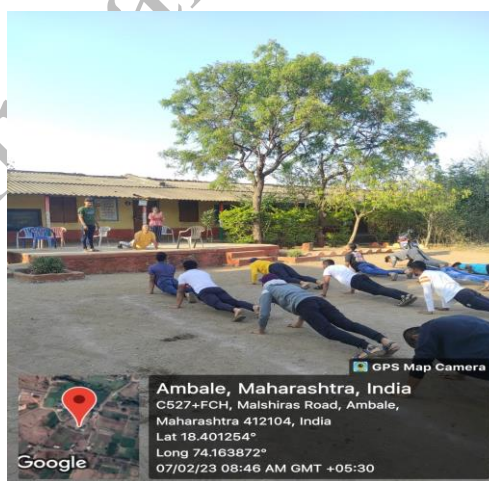

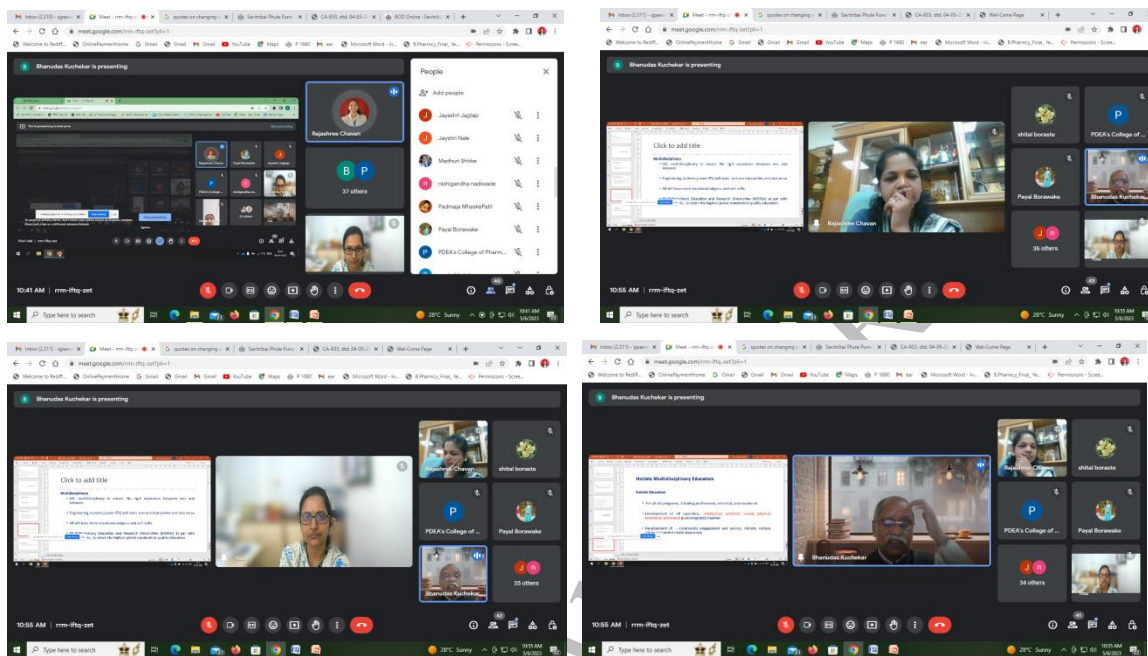
❖ One day Webinar on Implementation of NEP: Challenges & Opportunities
