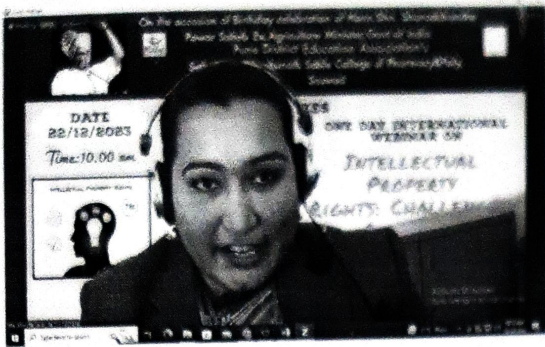

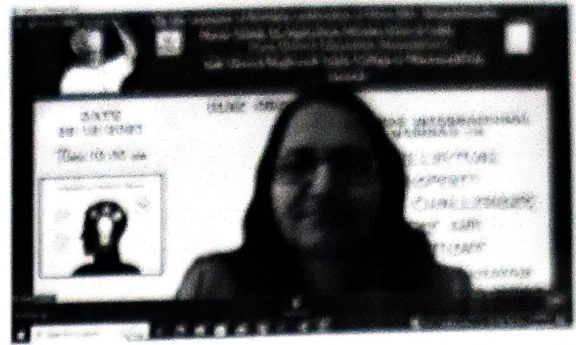

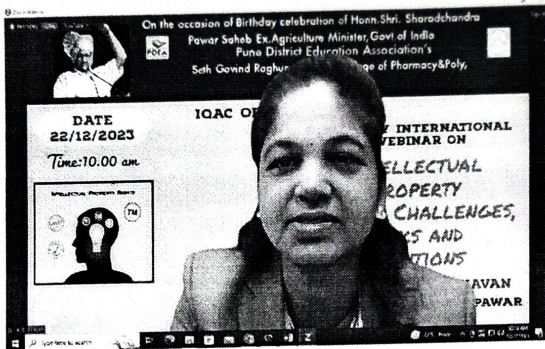
thanks by Dr. Amol Kale. The webinar was coordinated by Dr. Smita Pawar under the guidance of Dr. R. S. Chavan, Principal.



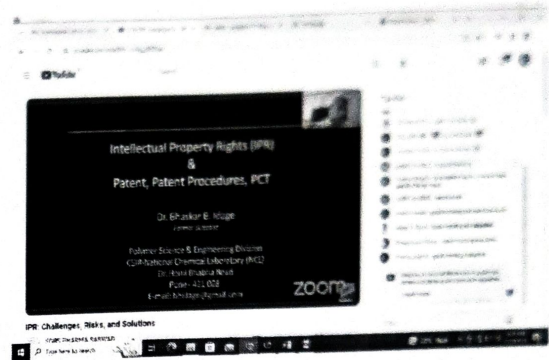

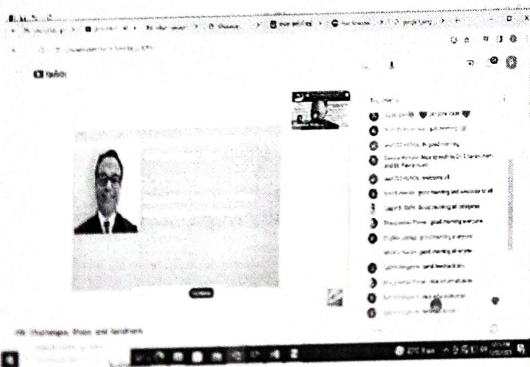
Dr. Smita Pawar, Coordinator delivering the preamble



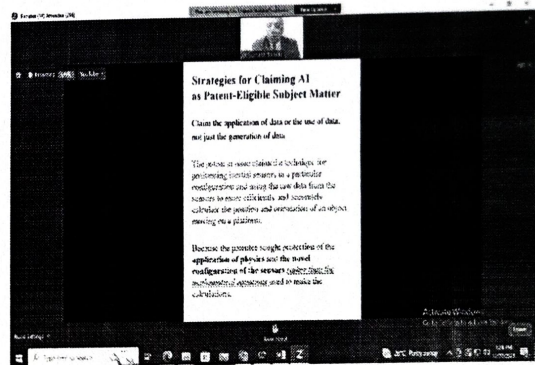

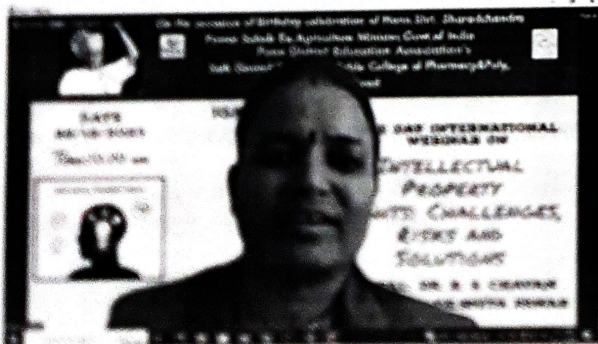
Dr. Bhaskar Inadge guiding the audience on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and Patent Filing Procedures.



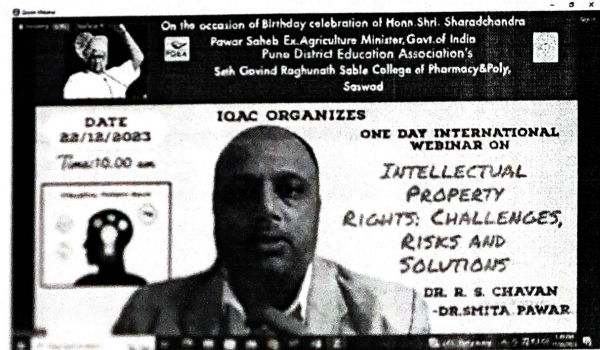
Dr. Prem Prakash Pathak discussing the Case Studies on Indian Patent Act and Pharmacy
