Q1. Where do you buy medicine from?

→ Distributors from - 1) Hadapsar - Vikas, Jeevanlaks
2) Saswad - Bharat, Shrinath,
3) Pune - Arvind distributors.

Q2. Is there any particular purchase day?

→ No, we place our order as per requirement and depending on stock remaining and order is arrived on same day.

Q3. How many days in advance you place your order and about how much stock is left?

→ We place order when there is enough stock for 3 to 4 days and about 15 to 20% stock is available in medical.

Q4. Which medicines do you purchase more?

→ Generally, we order all types of medicines, but mostly we purchase generic and ayurvedic medicines due to patient requirement and also it is reasonable.

Q5. Which mode do you prefer for billing?

→ Usually we prefer online payment mode, but sometimes we do cash or card payment also.

Q6. How do you check arrived stock?

→ There is a one register in which we maintained all stock information, after receiving the stock we check its batch number, manufacturing date, expiry and packaging. Also we checked the quantity with the bill, and only after stock is properly checked we complete the payment.

Q7. How much tax is charged on order?

→ Tax is charged only if the income amount is above 5 lakhs.

How do you order medicines that are not available and how long does it take for the order to arrive? If the medicine required by patient is not available, we immediately place order by calling and we try to fulfill patient's requirements.

The order is arrived depending on when we place order, if order is placed in morning it arrives in the evening and if order place in evening it will arrive on ~~mor~~ next day morning depending on time we inform to the patient.

Which mode do you prefer for placing your order? We place order by calling in the early time written order can also placed.

Now, app is also available for placing order, 'Pharma-rack' it is convenient but printed bill is not available, they sent bill on phone and that we have to upload on Computer for maintenance.

What are the different available discount schemes are there?

Discount is depends on billing amount For e.g

For 500 Rs bill - 1.5% discount is there.

Maximum upto -10% discount is available

In generic medicines there is no discount available due to greater competition distributors also give more discount.

What else you can tell us about purchase process?

Firstly, every pharmacist should be ethical and social towards patient. Purchasing can also be done where billing is now possible even at low cost. Number of substitutes can order of same category drug, there are so many substitutes are available of so many companies, but we ~~show~~ which shows good result.

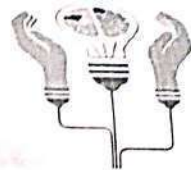
