



Staff and students expressed that they were feeling relaxed, refreshed and calm after this session.



## Demonstration of different Asanas & Pranayams by Mrs. Kamal Nanaware & Dr. Mrunal Jamdade












#### **Covid Care Program**

#### **Elocution Competition**






Celebration of Pune District Education Association's 80<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day and Nutrition Week
















**Ganesh Festival**






Celebration of "8th International Yoga Day"


